## **Christmas Decorations**

When can I install my Christmas Decorations?



Section 21, page 3 of the rules and regulations gives the timeline for installation of holiday decorations which is installation 30-days prior to the holiday and removal 7-days after the holiday.

## Wildlife in the Streets - Use Caution

We have seen more wildlife in different parts of the EPGCHA this year than any other year prior possibly due to drought conditions over the summer/fall season. This wildlife also crosses the City streets within the community and it's not always a quick process. Please use caution and drive slower speeds in areas where the wildlife are crossing.



### Sprinklers and Winter Use of Water

We just don't know what type of moisture we will receive any given season in Southern Oregon so some resident's do leave their irrigation systems on during the winter months. If you are actively watering your landscape in the winter months please make sure that you are running your system during the early afternoon hours or as otherwise appropriate so that the water runoff is not freezing. When the water runoff freezes on sidewalks and driveways it becomes a slip and fall hazard and we don't want to see anyone getting hurt.
