Landscape/Community Wide Standard

Now that the first day of spring has arrived here are a few tips and reminders on yard maintenance. Please note that these requirements are for the beautification of the community.

1) Did you know that pruning of plants and shrubs needs to be done correctly for proper health and growth? This includes trimming off the dead growth that appears on your plants during the winter months. There are some great tips for pruning of shrubs and plants on the OSU Extension Service website. 


Bulk Landscape Materials Order
