Hello Neighbors. As we approach fall I hope your summer was fruitful and fun. The Rogue Valley was, until the recent smoke and fire events, a great place to be outside exploring all that Southern Oregon has to offer.

Speaking of smoke, a great website to keep up to date on the fires in the region and beyond is Inciweb.com. It provides a link to each incident with detailed reports. If you have not already done so, you can also sign up for the Jackson County Emergency Alert System which will give you a text or call your landline, if you have one, with pending evacuation alerts. In dealing with the smoke you may want to consider a separate whole room HEPA air filter; there are many fine ones on the market. I use 'BlueAir" filters in several rooms. Once the smoke clears and cooler weather returns, get out and walk our lovely streets. It is a great way to meet people and make new friends, as well as getting that doctor recommended exercise.

Good news. The dedicated left turn lane from Alta Vista Road to Robert Trent Jones jr. Blvd. is now nearly complete, with initial striping occurring on Thursday August 24th. It should make that turn a lot safer for all.

Remember the first day of school for our local schools is the first week of September. Please be mindful of kids on the sidewalks and streets and stop for that school bus, when required.

### **Eagle Point Chief of Police Visit**

Jim Hamilton, the new Eagle Point Chief of Police, was present at the August 1, 2023 Board of Directors meeting to introduce himself and answer questions. Speeding on Arrowhead Trail and Robert Trent Jones Jr. Blvd and how to stop it was the main concern that was brought up. Mr. Hamilton relayed that the EPPD had performed 20 traffic stops within the HOA streets in July and issued 8 citations. Items discussed were possibly adding a portable radar for a time, more speed signs, traffic control bump-outs, speed bumps (not recommended) as well as additional stop signs installed at Arrowhead and Sand Pines. Jim Hamilton was going to bring the concerns up with COEP Engineering. The Association

has followed up with Jim Hamilton since that meeting and will bring you more details as we have them.

If you see vehicles speeding on any of the streets it is very important to do the following: 1) try to get the color, make, model and license plate of the vehicle. 2) call the EPPD non emergency number (541) 776-7206 to report the vehicle speeding. The COEP will focus on areas



with the most reported speeders so please make sure to call.

# **Proposed Resolutions**

### **Lawn Care - Reported Chinch Bugs**

There has been a report from an EPGCHA homeowner of finding Chinch bugs in their



lawn. They are a pest that can cause serious damage to lawns. Chinch bug damage in the pacific northwest is generally from mid to late summer. Drought conditions and heat cause the infestations to be worse which would explain why we are seeing these pests causing damage. 
